## Classroom Policies

- Class integration with private school kids (if available)
- Staff teacher will be the lead teacher
- You will be given a weekly plan to follow so what you are teaching at home follows what is being taught at school
- Graded homework is to be turned into lead teacher each week
- > Grades will be recorded by lead teacher
- Report cards provided by lead teacher on a predetermined schedule depending upon grade
- Parent is responsible for meeting expectations of the lead teacher
- Older students will be given quizzes to make sure material is covered at home (accountability)

### Curriculum

- Our core curriculum will be My Fathers World. This is a comprehensive preschool through high school curriculum that includes all subjects and combines the top learning philosophies (Classical Education, Charlotte Mason, Unit Studies, and Literature). Once you learn how their system works, you can quickly and easily move from one grade level to the next without gaps in learning.
- The King James version of the Bible will be used in all classes.
- All Bible and Science classes will be taught from a six literal days of Creation perspective.






Pre-K through Third Grade




Pre-Kindergarten





## My Father's World Family Learning Cycle Grades 4th to 8th

Each year, your family will use one Investigate package with all of your 4th-8th graders and keep moving through the cycle together each year. After completing 1850 to Modern Times, you will return to Exploring Countries and Cultures, learning the curriculum at a higher level and in greater depth than you did the first time; then you complete Creation to the Greeks, and so on.

We will offer up to two different classes for a single cycle each year:

- Upper Elementary (Grades 4,5,6)
- Middle School (Grades 7,8)






## My Father's World High School



We will offer two of these programs each year.


- Ancient History and World History for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Graders
- U.S. History 1 and U.S. History II for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Graders


9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Grade toggle
